- **JOB DEVELOPERS** Job Club participants can be placed in paid, permanent positions through subsidized employment and can also receive unsubsidized job leads.
- VOCATIONAL ASSESSMENT COUNSELORS-Job Club participants have the opportunity to develop vocational and self- employment plans, participate in career exploration, be assessed for Learning Disabilities, and/or have their degree evaluated.
- **COMMUNITY WORK EXPERIENCE (CWEX)**-Job Club participants are offered non-paid work experience with public and/or private businesses to help them learn valuable onthe-job skills and move into paid employment.
- JOB TALKS-Job Talks are offered for all Job Club participants to connect to employment in the community.
